When it comes to paying your monthly power bill, more and more members are choosing to set up automatic payments, so they can be assured their account will always be paid in a timely manner. We are pleased to be able to offer our members six ways to pay your bill.

Fergus Electric offers:

• Smarthub Online is available on our website. If you are new to Smarthub, sign up to access our Self Service site.

• Automatic Bank Draft. To sign up, complete the form on our website or contact the office for one to be mailed to you.

• You may pay using your credit and debit card by calling Fergus Electric's Call Capture Automated Phone System at 1-844-425-4302.

• You can mail your payment to the office. We ask that you include the bottom portion of your bill, and please allow time for the payment to be

received by the due date.

• We welcome you to stop in the office and pay in person. We are always happy to greet our members!

• Bank drop. To make it convenient for you, Fergus Electric has set up accounts at three Lewistown banks where you can drop off your payment: Stockman Bank, First National Bank and Bank of the Rockies.

Electric Cooperatives have an excellent history and relationship with those that serve in Montana's Legislative Chambers. We expect to work with them as they dive into the many issues to be discussed early next year.

# MECA AND FERGUS ELECTRIC SCHOLARSHPS

### GET YOUR APPLICATIONS IN BY JANUARY 25 FOR FOUR \$500 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

**T** o qualified students whose parents are cooperative members: If you are a high school senior planning to attend college or are a student continuing an undergraduate education, you could win a \$1,000 scholarship from Fergus Electric Cooperative and have a chance to win a \$500 scholarship from the Montana Electric Cooperatives' Association (MECA).

Scholarship applicants must:

1) Be a member of Fergus Electric Cooperative,

**2)** Be a graduating high school senior with plans to attend a university or vocational /technical school, or be an undergraduate college student,

**3)** Submit a completed application to Fergus Electric that includes school transcripts, ACT/SAT scores, a personal statement and one letter of recommendation,

And 4) Submit entries to Fergus Electric postmarked no later than *January 25, 2023* to MECA/Fergus Scholarship Committee, Fergus Electric Cooperative 84423 U.S. Highway 87, Lewistown, MT 59457.

Criteria for scholarship judging includes 20 percent academic strength (as demonstrated by coursework, GPA and national testing scores); 20 percent activities in school and community, awards and honors; 20 percent employment, volunteerism and community service, and 40 percent personal statement.

Fergus Electric will select one application to be forwarded to MECA in Great Falls for further judging. A MECA committee will choose the scholarship recipients from the pool of finalists. Fergus Electric will also award one scholarship from the applications.
